There are many reasons why Wakatobi remains one of the world’s premier dive destinations. A privately-funded marine preserve encompasses some of the planet’s most pristine and biodiverse coral ecosystems; socially conscious business practices create lasting benefits for both guests and the local community; and unmatched attention to personal service guarantees a dive vacation like no other.

It begins with a concierge greeting on arrival in Bali, and exclusive private charter flights to the resort. Oceanside villas and bungalows create an ambiance

Just off the beach is Wakatobi’s legendary House Reef. More than three miles long, this site combines creature-rich shallows with a dramatic coral ridge. A fleet of spacious, custom-built dive boats access more than 40 additional sites. Many sites begin shallow and drop precipitously — ideal for long multi-level dive profiles or snorkeling. Wakatobi is also renowned for the multitude of species on its reefs, including a number of rare and unusual species

of pygmy seahorses and invertebrates. An international team handles every detail of the dive experience, including instruction, private guide services, private boats and photography support.

Other activities include kitesurfing, kayaking, paddleboarding, nature and island tours, seminars, photo workshops and even Indonesian cooking and culture classes.
